An Ounce of Prevention...

With the New Year, we are thankful for the blessings of families, roofs over our heads and stocked pantries. Let's talk about dangers that may be lurking inside pantries. There are 2 million cases of poisoning a year, half in children under 5. Every household has cleaning supplies, plants, medicines, pesticides and common chemicals.

Here are some helpful tips to keep your family safe from accidental poisoning:

- Follow all directions on the label
- Keep medicines and chemicals in their original containers
- NEVER share prescription drugs
- Keep all medicines and chemicals out of reach of children
- Dispose of expired medicines
- Never mix chemicals. Mixing can cause dangerous gases and fumes
- Have plenty of ventilation when using indoor chemicals

If you have an accidental poisoning, remain calm. If the victim is not conscious, call 911. If the victim is awake and alert, call 1-800-222-1222 (National Poison Control).
