RENTER'S INSURANCE

As of February 1st, Personal Property Coverage will also no longer be included. It is not a requirement that residents purchase their own renter's insurance but it is highly recommended. In the event of extreme weather conditions, fire, flood, theft, etc. the resident is responsible for any damages. If you do decide to acquire your own personal property insurance it is not required that you notify our office.

COMMUNITY CENTER RENTAL POLICY

Effective February 1, 2018 we will start to charge a flat \$50.00 fee for all active military/residents to rent out the community center for events. Any non-residents may also rent out the community center for \$100.00. This space includes use of the complete kitchen, party/conference room, and access to 7 rectangular tables plus 40 chairs.
