PCS Season: Just a reminder that we will soon be entering PCS season. Please make sure to provide the office a **30-day notice** if you are planning on leaving.

Before Getting a Pet – Things You Should Know:

- Aggressive dog breeds are not allowed in Goodfellow Family Housing. Be sure to check the pet addendum for a list of aggressive breeds before acquiring your pet.
- Notify the Leasing Office within five (5) day of acquiring the pet.
- \$100 non-refundable pet fee and verification of immunizations is required.
- Pets must be on a leash at all times unless inside the dog park or a fenced area.
- Pets are not allowed in common areas unsupervised or off the leash at any time.

Pest Control: Insects are a fact of life in Texas! Call or submit a work order anytime you're experiencing pests or insects in your home. We want to make sure your homes are pest-free.
